Later this month, we will see children dressed in their Halloween costumes. I remember seeing children dressed as devils back in my day. Silly huh! But if you believe in God, you must face a reality of evil. So, let 's think about a healthy appreciation of how much the Devil/Satan desires to destroy us. The author of lies wants to steal, kill, and destroy Christ's followers (John 10:10). Satan lured Adam and Eve to compromise their trust in God by eating from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, and from there he has brought unspeakable brokenness to the human race and to the earth. Today, that strategy is still being brought to bear by Satan.

Too often people spend years ignoring this reality. Sometimes pleading ignorance (which is often in us a chosen naïveté), leads to paying a heavy price as we realize that the sin that has been embedded in our life has an origin. There is not time to waste in our effort to pick up sword and shield and fight the good fight. We can look at Jesus' words for inspiration. Just before He goes to Gethsemane and the cross, Jesus urges us not to let our hearts be afraid. Then he says to His disciples, ***"I will not speak with you much longer, for the prince of this world is coming. He has no hold on me, but the world must learn that I love the Father and that I do exactly what my Father has commanded me."*** (John 14:30-31)

Satan has no hold on me! Satan's only power is that which we give him when we participate in the effort to steal, kill, or destroy. The Good News is that God calls us to examine our lives and turn (repent) from sin. While we offer our confession we are encouraged to be much more. The United Methodist Church calls it working toward perfection. It is a continuing effort toward obedience. It is out of thankful hearts and in response to God's mercy and grace, we work toward correcting anything that might contribute to the enemy's plans.

Just imagine for a moment if you were fortress against all the ploys, accusations, temptations, snares, lies, assaults, and deceptions of the enemy. What would it be like if they had no effect on you? Your life would be a joy to live, and you would be a mighty warrior for the kingdom of God on earth for the rest of your life.
