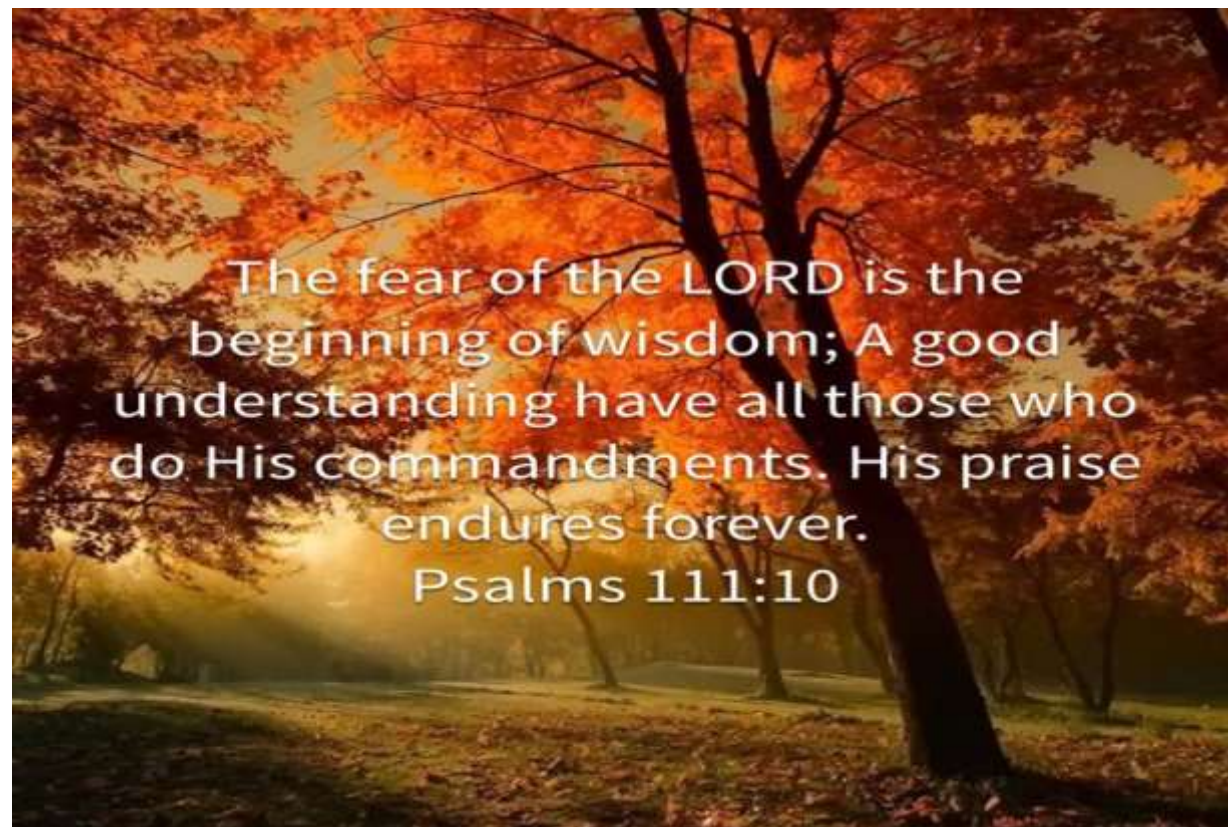

One of the most unique things Jesus says to his disciples and to you and me is this, "*Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.*" (John 14:27). Did you know you have a choice? This is jarring, even surprising to most of us. Wait—do not let your heart be troubled? I thought to myself, *we have a choice?* They still don't believe or don't *want* to believe he's leaving, and they are worried, anxious, and indeed, fearful.

Most of us presume it to be the opposite of our choice. We think the world hands us a toxic, spoiled, nasty circumstance, sometimes of our own doing, and we react to it in a fearful, anxious manner. Trouble descends: your house is robbed, there is an issue with your child, a test comes back not in your favor, you lose your job... etc... What do you think? Do you say to yourself, "*This doesn't have to take me out. I'm not going to let my heart be troubled. No way.*" Or do we think with a troubled heart?" "What on earth will I do? How am I going to deal with this?" The latter seems unavoidable, and basically even appropriate.

You have a choice! Yes, you do! Did you notice that when your heart is troubled it is always asking the question, "*What am I going to do?*" Can you imagine what it would be like to immediately look to God and say, "*What are you going to do? How are we going to handle this?*" When you practice giving it to God, you become better at it. Our challenge is to identify our self-centeredness in our troubles and begin to turn to God in all instances and give it to God. Then we listen for God when we act on our trouble. This is key... we listen, then act, and then it will not be out of fear, but out of our discipleship as we follow what God is going to lead us into.
