

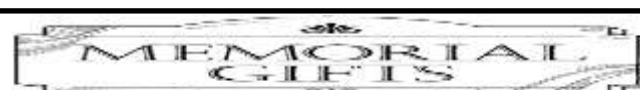

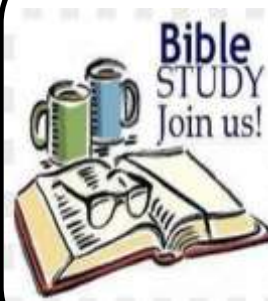
The committee will not meet in January, but the next Mission's meeting is February 9thth at 6:30 in the JKH classroom.
